Health economics has developed and expanded over the last sixty years, starting from the concerns that obsessed economists at the beginning: the growth of health care spending, spurred by technology and imperfect markets, the difficult management of health care and the central problem of reconciling the two major objectives of the system, efficiency and equity.

Times have changed a lot since then and have brought other concerns, new methods, more and better data.

Hacienda Publica (HPE)/Review of Public Economics is launching a special issue devoted to Health Economics as a theoretical discipline and as a practical set of tools for better deciding how to manage healthcare and how to allocate resources for health in a society. Our aim is that this special issue will contribute to new theoretical developments and practical solutions to emerging problems in the post-covid world, at the micro, meso and macro levels. Also, what role health economists must play, their relationships with other scientists and what methodological changes are needed.

Original research articles are welcome. Specific topics may include, but are not restricted to:

- Global health and economic evaluation
- New challenges in healthcare management
- Health Systems in transition
- New data, new methods in health Economics
- Interfaces with other disciplines

HPE/Review of Public Economics is the leading journal on Public Economics in Spain and this special issue will be edited by Guillem Lopez Casasnovas and Beatriz Gonzalez Lopez-Valcarcel. All the submitted papers will be peer reviewed by referees. The planned date for publication of the issue is November 2023, but the accepted papers will be published electronically as soon as they are ready.
